I am pleased to announce that we will once again be offering **an after school Spanish class for any interested students in grades 1-3. The initial offering of this class will begin after our Winter Holiday on Tuesday, January 8<sup>th</sup> and continue for a total of eight sessions, concluding on Thursday, January 31<sup>st</sup>.

## **Kindergarten Registration for 2019-2020 School Year**

For registration information, please contact Suzanne Borgert in the school office at 833-2500. Kindergarten registration is open to children who turn five on or before September 1, 2019. Parents must provide proof that they are a Kenwood resident.

Transitional Kindergarten registration is open to children who reside within the Kenwood School District boundaries and whose fifth birthday is between September 2 and December 2, 2019.

If you reside outside of the Kenwood School District boundaries, you will need to file a District of Choice Transfer Form with the Kenwood School office by January 1, 2019.

Dear Kenwood Families,
