Principally Speaking “Operation Cool Down”

Greetings to all families!

Well, if it is not one thing, it is another. We have been working hard to make sure our students stay safe and as cool as possible. This unprecedented heat wave has created a few unique challenges. Luckily our staff is well versed in thinking outside the box, and we have developed a plan for days that have extreme temperatures.

We will keep students indoors when temperatures reach 90 degrees. Typically, 90 degrees isn't unhealthy, but we have found that many students have a hard time taking it easy. They play hard and don't notice the heat like adults do.

Bringing the students inside during these high temperatures, affects Recess/Lunch, PE, Garden as well as Cougar Club outdoor activities. However, we do have the ability to bring Lunch and PE into the cafeteria and Garden into the STEAM room. This allows our Enrichment Specialists the opportunity to continue their programs and provide a safe learning experience for our kids.

We are also concerned with the strain on our electric grid. If for some reason, Kenwood School loses power during these high temperatures, it will be difficult to keep students safe inside the classrooms. We may have to close school if interior temperatures begin to rise too much. If we do encounter this scenario, the school does have enough back up power to notify the community that school will be closed due to excessive heat during a power outage. We do not expect this to happen but are prepared if it does.
