


Principally Speaking

Attendance Update:

We are moving into cold and flu season and would like to remind families that although school attendance is a priority, we want to keep all staff and students as healthy as possible. Students should stay home if they are not feeling well or if they have had a fever within the last 24 hours. Masks are an effective tool in limiting the spread of any disease. If your child is recovering from an illness and still has a stuffy nose, please consider sending them to school with a mask for the protection of others. It is also helpful to teach students to sneeze into the corner of their elbow while turning their head from others. And of course it is always a great idea to wash their hands before eating, after using the bathroom and returning from recess.



Reminders:

During student Pick Up and Drop Off, please remember to pull as far forward as you can. If you can pull up to the US mailbox, please do. Also, remember to have students exit the vehicle on the passenger side of the car and for adults to remain in the car for a quick and efficient process.

Accelerated Reader News:

Parents, We would like to give you a couple tools to help your student(s) complete their Accelerate Reader goals. The following are items that you may find helpful.

1) If you are picking a book from the store or from your home library, the app, "**Points Scan**" by Straight Path Apps (located at the Apple Store on your iPhone), can help parents find the book level, points, and quiz number of a book by scanning the book's barcode.

2) The Quick Search at arbookfind.com gives suggestions for books to read based on title, author, series, or topic. After a title, author, or topic has been put in the search bar, the search may be refined using the menu bar on the left to look for interest level: *lower grades* or *middle grades*. *Lower Grades* are K-3rd grade and *Middle Grades* are 4th-8th grades. (*Upper Grades* are 9th-12th grades). Book levels, as well as *fiction* or *nonfiction* options may also be selected.


