
Lost and Found



Gratitude for a Big HeART

As you may know, Kenwood Education Foundation works tirelessly to generate funds for Kenwood Elementary School's enrichment programs, including art, music, STEAM, library, gardening, after-school child care, and physical education.

Within a few weeks of the article's publication, Linda contacted our Superintendent and Principal, Nate Myers, to share the news that she had reached out to the Sonoma Plein Air board and they had agreed to consider a grant request from Kenwood Elementary School. She encouraged us to apply for a significant grant and graciously offered to act as our liaison. Without her selfless efforts, we would have missed out on this opportunity.

Thanks to Linda Rosso's big heart, the Sonoma Plein Air Foundation has provided the funds to fully support our art program for the ongoing school year at Kenwood Elementary School. We are beyond grateful for Linda, the Sonoma Plein Air Foundation, and our Sonoma Valley community. We hope this news lifts your spirits and sheds some light on the deep affection our community has for our beloved little school.
